

60304 Colophony, dark brown

Colophony, dark brown is gained from the "Pinus massoniana" species from China.

The Colophony dark contains more ethereal oils and coloring components than the light colophonies. The dark rosin is especially suitable for the production of violin-varnish-rosins. The procurement of the dark rosin is very difficult, because nowadays the light rosin is cheaper than the dark one and therefore there is no real market for the dark rosin
