

O6055 Shellac wax, bleached

Shellac wax is mainly a mixture of esters (approx. 60 %) and free alcohols (approx. 35 %). Furthermore, it contains small amounts of hydrocarbons, penta- and hentriacontanes and approx. 1 % varnish acid.
