Grade 0000:

Polishing waxed wood. Smooth matt finish for highly polished wooden surfaces. Removal of water stains on waxed wood.



Grade 1:


Grinding and polishing wood surfaces after priming and before applying first coat of paint.

Grade 2: Spreading wax on wood and stone floors in a thin,



Grade EXTRA FINE:

For smoothing wood with high tannin content, e.g. oak, walnut or mahogany, without discolouring the grain.



PAINT

Grade 000:

For intermediate grinding on varnish or shellac

Grade 1:

even layer.

In combination with varnish remover, removal of old varnish from antiques.





Grade MEDIUM:

For thoroughly removing paint residue without danger of rusting, even on outer surfaces.



Grade 000:

Gives a bright shine to items made of copper or brass.



Grade 0:

Removal of oxidation on copper, polishing copper pipes and fittings before soldering.

Grade FINE:

Ideal for complete and hygienic cleaning of cooking utensils, etc.



CLEANING

Grade 00:

Grease and soot removal from plastic blinds and aluminium window frames.



Cleaning glass and mirror surfaces.

Grade 0:

Complete removal of dirt and footprints from linoleum and rubber floors

Grade 2: Removal of wax and dirt residue on wooden surfaces. Cleaning floor and wall tiles as well as plastic tiles.





Grade COARSE:

For removing even stubborn stains and dirt deposits on tiles and ceramic floors, especially in bathrooms, kitchens and other wet areas.
